Metsähovi Radio Observatory is a separate research institute of TKK/ETA and has a worldwide reputation in the following fields:

- Radio astronomy and multifrequency astronomy of Active Galactic Nuclei and the Sun.
- Very Long Baseline Interferometry (VLBI).
- Development of instruments and methods needed in radio astronomy, VLBI and space research.

Metsähovi operates a 14-m radio telescope in Kirkkonummi. The telescope is used for radio astronomical observations in the microwave and millimetre domains.
